# DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

---



Throughout 2021, SustainEd Farms grew significantly! We more than doubled our partners, services, and produce grown again. With schools reopening, we received more requests for programming than ever before – truly affirming the value of our partnerships and work. Over 5,000 students had access to our gardens in 2021.

This year we prioritized soil regeneration, composting, intercropping, and general sustainable production, as we know our farm sites are an important addition to food security within our communities. This allowed us to grow 3,635 pounds of fresh, healthy produce, which we distributed right back into our communities through our Farm Share program. To spread our impact further throughout the community, we donated twenty percent of our total produce grown to Bienvenidos Food Bank each week of the Farm Share program.

As an organization we are more than just these numbers; at the heart of our work is our mission: *growing food; growing knowledge; growing justice*. What we truly value as an organization is working closely with our school partners to create tailored garden spaces that meet the learning-needs of students and the production-needs of our community. In 2022, we have committed to expanding our impact even more. We will be taking on 10 additional garden sites in Denver Public Schools, branching into early childhood centers, and distributing 30% more of our produce throughout the Denver area.

We couldn't do this without our contributors, partners, and greater community! Thank you for your continued support, and we look forward to growing with you throughout 2022.

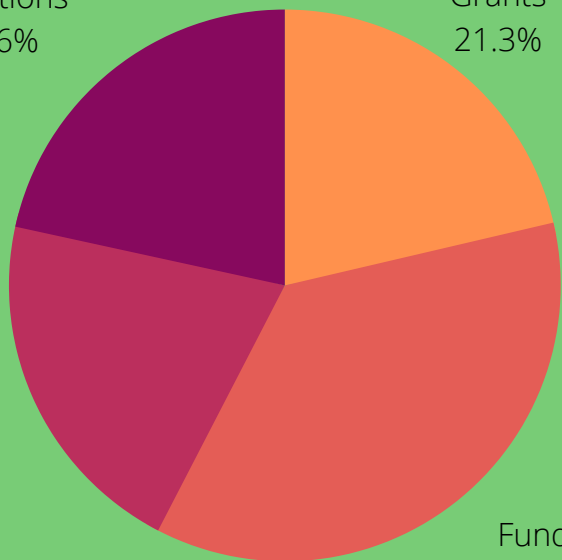

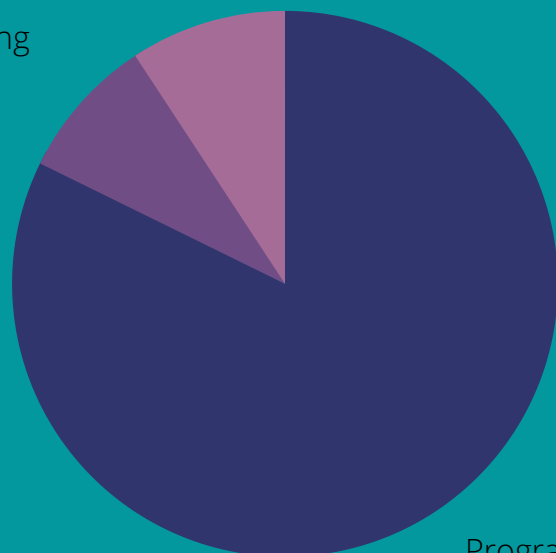
